Act 1 – The will

Scene 1

Law firm's lobby. There is no one in the lobby. The phone rings, Ravit walks in holding an instant noodle cup, she pick's up the phone

Ravit: Edelstein, Perelshtein, and Biton law firm, this is Ravit speaking...
Ronit, why are you calling the office?...But you know we aren't allowed to hold the line... Then call my cell phone... What radiation, Ronit? Where did you read that? ...Ok. I'm hanging up now...I'm not being cold...Is that why you called, Ronit? The holiday is in three weeks!...Yeah, I'm hosting, I remember, I remember...I remem- Fine we'll do it now. Jeess... I'd like to remind you we said we're not going overboard with food this year
Ok, write this down: Mom is making the fish plus the sauce for the fish plus the Tabouli salad Remind her not to put onion in the Tabouli, because Yakir doesn't like onions, Beetroot salad, eggs salad, chopped liver, Dad said he's taking care of the soft drinks, soda drinks, alcoholic drinks, green broad bean, nuts, I'll make the stuffed vegetables, orange soup, cauliflower with tahini, eggplant with tahini, tahini, Okra, pear tart, carrot cake, And you'll make your swiss chard, green salad, creamy mushrooms, sweet potatoes with bechamel sauce, Your Savarin cake, compote for dad, And that's it, we don't need to go overboard... Oh, make a Weldoff Salad too. And a surprise salad And rice with raisins And rice without raisins because Yakir doesn't like raisins! And vine leaves and the marinated chicken ... What? No, no, no You're making the chicken... 'Cause I don't do marinated chicken... Because I'm not- I'm not making-... Because it grosses me out to spread the sauce on

the chicken, that's why!... No, no! You're not calling mom... Ronit, you're not asking her- Ronit seriously!...Have mercy on mom!...

Gur enter's to the lobby. Ravit whisper's to the phone

Ravit: Ok, fine! I'll make the marinated chicken

But I'm giving you the stuffed vegetables and the Okra And I'm adding you coleslaw salad... Because that's how it is Ronit. I'm the hostess, and that's what I've decided **to Gur** Yeh?

Gur: Excuse me, can I park outside?

Ravit: Light gray you can, dark gray you can't, blue and white on the right side you can until 5 pm if you're a city resident... **to the phone**

Enough with the stuffed vegetables, Ronit, I'm working, On the days you're working I don't call you every five minutes **to Gur** Yes? Who are you here for?

Gur: Attorney Biton.

Ravit: My condolences.

Gur: Why? Is he a bad attorney?

Ravit: No, Biton is great. But, Biton is only wills. Wills opening, wills editing, wills writing. You don't look like a person who would write a will, so I expressed my condolence. Just a catch phrase. **to the phone** Just a second, Ronit. **to Gur** You're for the will opening at half-past?

Gur: Yes, but I'm waiting for my sister

Ravit: Attorney Biton asked to tell you something. Now, where did I put it? Where did I put it? My head is somewhere else. My sister just stabbed me in the back... **to the phone** That's right, Ronit! To me,

the marinated chicken is a stab in the back! **to Gur** ohhh here it is,
read from the note "If Gur and Ayelet Barkai arrive, tell them I'm
held up at the dentist"

Gur: So we won't be received at half-past?

Ravit: Teeth pain. It's force majeure **to the phone** Enough with the holiday,
Ronit! **to Gur** Wow, excuse me. What a nightmare. It's just that I'm
hosting this year, and it's such a bad timing My husband wants to
renovate-

Gur: Excuse me-

Ravit: And it's right on the holiday-

Gur: If my sister Ayelet gets here, tell her Gur is moving his car, ok?
goes to the door

Ravit: **to the phone** Just a second, Ronit... **to Gur** Is your name Gur?

Gur: Yes

Ravit: You're Gur the Traffic Sign (Goor the Tamroor)

Gur: That's me

Ravit: Hooo I didn't recognize you without the thing and the- **make a
triangle shape around her head** Wow! **to the phone** Ronit you won't
believe who's here, Gur the Traffic Sign! **to Gur** Do you remember
you had a show at the Yellow-Weed mall?

Gur : At the-?

Ravit: Remember what you said at the end of the show? "Kids! Who is
ready to cross the road, according to the lifesaving rules of gold?"
And then Yakir, That's my son, Yakir. So he yelled: "Me! Me!"

And then you said that you only invite kids who sit quietly and raise their hand And you invited this one girl with glasses

But then she was shy, the four-eyes, and then my son set quietly, and you invited him Remember Yakir? **Show him a picture on her cell phone**

Gur : aaa-

Ravit: Wow the kid loves you so much, He loves you so much We bought "Gur the Traffic Sign" on DVD, and now we sing the songs all day long **sing** "*look to the left/ and then to the right/ to the left again/ and to the sounds we listen!*" hoo My sister is singing too! **to the phone** Ronit, you won't believe how tall he is in person **to Gur** you have no idea how much the kids loves you, Every time he sees a traffic sign, he says: "It's Gur the Traffic sign!" So who died? Your mother or father?

Gur : Father

Ravit: Wow. A father. that's a wow. And the mother too?

Gur : a long time ago

Ravit: Wow, wow, both the mother and the father, God rest their souls, amen, Tell me can you make a video for Yakir?

Ayelet enter's

Ayelet: Go eat mac and cheese! did you hear what I said? Go eat mac and cheese!

Gur : What's wrong Ayelet?

Ayelet: Why aren't you picking up your phone? Is it too much for you to pick me up?

Gur : Do you know what would happen if someone sees 'Gur the Traffic Sign' talking on the phone while driving?

Ravit: **sing** “When you drive/ you don’t talk/ and tell that to your folks!”

* It's a song from the DVD of 'Gur the Traffic Sign'

Ayelet: Do you know how humiliating it is to take the 61 bus? No Gur, you don’t know. And you know what’s even more humiliating than taking the 61 bus? Getting off the bus, walking for an hour to get here, and then seeing your brother’s white Jeep parking right outside

Gur : When you saw the Jeep did it have a ticket on it by any chance?

Ayelet: **to Ravit** Get this, the fact that his sister walk for an hour is nothing compared to a 250 shekels parking ticket

Gur : **to Ravit** The tickets here are 250 shekels?!

Ayelet: Why did the Shiva have to end? Why?

Shiva - (Judaism) seven day mourning period for a close relative

Ravit: Stop it, that’s the grief talking

Ayelet: No, that’s me talking. I had more fun at the Shiva than I had on my honeymoon. A whole week, no cooking, no cleaning. Everybody says “my condolences Ayelet”, “Can I help you Ayelet?”, I came back to school today and Hanit Malka from the third grade called me 'a whore'. Why aren’t we going in?

Ravit: Attorney Biton is at the dentist. **to the phone** Wow, his sister is pissed off.

Gur : Ayelet, I’m going to move the Jeep **open the door out**

Ayelet: What's the deal !? Sella will get here, and you won’t be here.

Gur : Sella will get where? Sella is back in the country?

Ayelet: Yes. He arrived this morning. He didn't call you?

Gur : No. did he call you?

Ayelet: He called in the middle of class and asked for the attorney's address

Gur : And didn't he ask for the address of the cemetery?

Ayelet: Go eat mac and cheese!

Gur : You go eat mac and cheese. What Ayelet? Don't I have a reason to be pissed-off?

Ayelet: What do you want from him? Did he know dad was going to die?

Gur : I wouldn't fly abroad while my dad is dying

Ayelet: Dad was dying for six months

Gur : When Sella left, we know it was the end. Never mind, I don't want to fight today. **open the door out**

Ayelet: Fine, then don't fight

Ravit: **to the phone** That's it they stopped fighting.

Gur : But It's annoying! Don't tell me it's not annoying We take care of the hospital, we take care of the funeral, we take care of the Shiva

Ayelet: I took care of the Shiva.

Gur : Ok Ayelet, you live near dad.

Ayelet: So what? You live near the hospital and I was still over there more than you.

Gur : Ayelet, I'm an actor. Do you know what an actor is? An actor is like a doctor, I cannot cancel shows just because my dad passed away, And besides, I'm taking care of the gravestone.

Ayelet: You're comparing a gravestone to a Shiva?

Gur : I'm comparing two siblings who did everything for their father And their older brother who just had to go now, of all times, without his phone, With no way to communicate, he just had to go to a hugging workshop in Ecuador

Ayelet: Ok, OK, go move the Jeep.

Gur opens the door and then closes it and turn's to Ravit

Gur : Excuse me, can I ask a hypothetical question?

Ravit: **to the phone** Just a second Ronit, I'm being asked a question.

Gur : Let's say your brother would go abroad-

Ravit: I don't have a brother, I have a sister **to the phone** We're not talking about you, it's hypothetical.

Gur : So let's assume your sister would go abroad right when your father is dying -

Ravit: Hi hi hi! What's this all about? My father is healthy as a horse, thank god.

Gur : Fine, but's let's assume, just assuming he was dying and then dies-

Ravit: No no! Don't assume, who'd assume stuff like that?!

Gur : I didn't mean t-

Ravit: I through listening! **to the phone** Gur the Traffic Sign, said dad would die.

Ayelet: Listen to me little baby.

Gur : **whisper** don't call me little baby in front of people.

Ayelet: Listen, Gur, when Sella gets here, I don't want to hear a word about the money you loaned him

Gur : Wrong, Ayelet. A loan is when you get the money back, I know for a fact that I will never see the 8,000 shekels I gave him.

8000 shekels = 2300 \$

Ayelet: Ok fine, we're talking about Sella here, What do you expect? That he'll change at his age?

Gur : So he won't change, but I don't want him hugging me anymore, Great, he found his system, whenever he needs something from you, He just comes and hugs you, He can keep smoking drugs for the rest of his life, but not with my money.

Ayelet: enough, don't be a baby, you're going to get a lot of money today.

Gur : right, because 8,000 shekels is not a lot of money?

Ayelet: To me it's a lot, to you it's not a lot.

Gur : It's a lot to me too -

Ayelet: Stop it Gur -

Gur : And, it's annoying you all think I have money.

Ayelet: Because you have money.

Ravit: **to the phone** Of course he has money.

Gur : I don't have money! **Whisper** And even if I have a little bit of money, This is a time when we really need money.

Ayelet: No, Gur. I'm at a time when I need money, And until you'll be a single parent, you won't understand what it means, to be at a time when you need money.

Gur : So I have news for you: Moran and I will soon need more money.

Ayelet: Get out of here!

Gur : shshshsh

Ayelet: Little baby! Are you guys pregnant?

Gur : Not yet, But we stopped using birth control.

Ayelet: And are you also having sex?

Gur : We're thinking about that too. But not a word! Especially not to Sella.

Ayelet: come on for a second... **Pulls him aside to sit down far from Ravit so she wouldn't hear** Tell me, do you know how much we're going to get?

Gur : Oh, at the...

Ayelet: Yes...

Gur : Not sure about every saving he had, but he should have a nice pension from the military.

Ayelet: So pension, savings all that. Will it be a million shekels?

Gur : More or less...

Ayelet: And the apartment? How much is the house worth?

Gur : 2.5 million, maybe more...

Ayelet :Nice... Nice... I wonder how he divided it?

Gur : What was that?

Ayelet: I wonder how dad divided the money, You know... you have money, Moran's family has money-

Gur : Ayelet stop whining! Stop it, stop it! You're going to get a third! A third. That's a lot of money

Ayelet: You didn't even hear me out and you-

Gur : I need to go move the Jeep

Ayelet: Don't you need to move the yacht too?

Gur : Go eat mac and cheese!

Ayelet: you go eat mac and cheese!

Gur : You go eat mac and cheese!

Sella enters

Sella: Maybe I'll eat mac and cheese?

Gur : Hi Sella, thank you for making it-

Sella: Shhhh

Ayelet: What's wrong?

Sella: Shhhh... A hug. **Sela holds his arms out for a hug**

Gur looks at Ayelet with reproof. Ayelet approaches Sella and hugs him

Sella: Gur you can join whenever

Gur takes a breath, and then joins for a triple hug

Ravit: **to the phone** The third one arrived, they're hugging now
Poor things, their father passed away.

Sella: How was it?

Gur : How was what? The funeral? The Shiva?

Sella: The hug, How was the hug?

Ayelet: Oh, Yeah, No, it was a very good hug.

Gur : A great hug, Worth at least 8,000 shekels.

Sella: Right, little baby, thank you for reminding me I owe you money

Gur : Oh that, I completely forgot about it. Pay me back whenever you can.

Sella: Great! If you don't need it right now that's great! Because I had a business idea, Tell me if it's a great idea or what... A restaurant That only serves goat's yogurt With Za'atar that they ground in front of you

Pause

Gur : It'll probably go like crazy

Sella: You were being sarcastic?

Gur : Sarcastic? me? Who wouldn't want to eat a good goat's yogurt?

Sella: You were being sarcastic. You said it sarcastically

Ayelet: Yes, he was being sarcastic.

Sella: Why? Why do you do stuff like that? You know how much sarcasm hurts me... Do you know that sarcasm finished western society? **He pulls out a joint**

Gur : Sella, Sella! You can't smoke here

Sella: Excuse me, little baby. It's the grief... So we're orphans now? We have so much to talk about... You wanna go eat Hummus at "Abu-Ramzi"? Gur is buying.

Abu-Ramzi – name of an Arab restaurant

Gur : Why me?

Sella: Because you're the youngest

Ayelet: No, no, no wait a minute Sella, We're supposed to open the will now.

Sella: Oh, the will... Listen, that will is the last thing dad wanted to tell us, right? So why do we need to listen to it in this office?

Ayelet: Where do you want us to listen to it? At Abu Ramzi?

Sella: No, no! we'll go to the cemetery, we'll sit on dad's grave, we'll eat something, Drink something, smoke something, and read the will.

Ayelet: Sella, Attorney Biton is supposed to read us the will now.

Sella: But I still haven't said my goodbyes to dad.

Gur : We did say our goodbyes to dad! We said our goodbyes at the hospital, at the funeral, at the Shiva, We said our goodbyes.

Sella: And you're angry with me that I wasn't there with you, right?

Gur : Not angry at all. To each his own

Sella: Right, because you think Sella is travelling the world, smoking drugs, right? You think I flew to Ecuador to hug and have sex with people I don't know, right?

Gur : Right.

Sella: Wrong! Wrong! My heart is searching for something, So it's searching for it in Ecuador, it's searching for it here. Searching!

Gur : So get a job, earn money and you can search all you want

Ayelet: Enough Gur!

Sella: So it's about the 6,000 shekels you loaned me, right?

Gur : You know what- It's 8,000 shekels!

Sella: The moment I heard the universe took dad All I cared about was, how am I going to take care of my two younger siblings And all you two care about is if I pay you back the money or not I pay you back.

Gur : You will pay us back!

Sella: You said you have no problem loaning me money.

Gur : I lied, I do have a problem loaning you money.

Sella: Gur, go eat mac and cheese!

Gur : You go eat mac and cheese!

Sella: Go eat mac and cheese!

Ayelet: Enough, shitheads! I'd appreciate it if we could try not to fight today! Is that alright with you?

Ravit: **to the phone** The sister, she's the dominant one.

Ayelet: Do you understand that my life depends on what I'm about to get in there? So if you don't care about money, and you're drowning in money-

Gur : I'm drowning in money?

Ayelet: Gur, shut up, ok? Listen, I don't go showing you the pathetic paycheck I get from the ministry of education, I don't tell you how much Lotus's psychologist costs or Yotam's dietitian, and I didn't tell you that Doron stopped paying his alimony, right?

Sela goes closer to hug her

Ayelet: I don't want a hug Sella! I don't want a hug! All I want is to go in there, get something I can give to my kids, and If I can maybe buy a lousy Toyota Because I don't want to spend the rest of my miserable life on the 61 bus. So can we please get through this miserable half an hour without fighting?

Lotus – name of Ayelet's daughter

Lawyer Biton enters the office frantically holds his face and speaks unclearly

Biton: Hello! Hello! My apologies, I'm sorry I'm late, Wisdom tooth, Hurts like hell, I cried less at my circumcision, The doctor said he had never seen anything like it, The germs build a city inside the tooth the size of Hadera (Hadera- name of an Israeli medium town)

Turns to Ravit Ronit, get the papers for the will opening

Biton: Ravit! **To the phon** Yes, he mixed us up again.

Biton: Ravit, Ravit, right. She and her twin sister work here, Can't tell the difference between them even when I'm not under anaesthesia.

Ayelet: Are we going in?

Biton: Yes, yes, of course, come on, Now, where is that wisdom tooth? At the edge of the jaw, So to get to it, they had to cut through my entire gums, The amount of blood I spat... The battle of Ammunition Hill had less blood spilled, Oh, that's not nice, that's not nice, My mother's brother was killed at the Ammunition Hill, that's not nice, It's just not my day, Now, because I didn't want to be late, I was driving so fast that I scratched some Jeep outside

Gur : What did you scratch? What colour was the jeep?

Biton: White, probably someone loaded His fault. He didn't park properly I saw he got a ticket too, Come, let's go inside

Ammunition Hill - very famous battle with a lot of dead

Lawyer Biton leads the three siblings into his office while Ravit calls after gur: "Wait Gur what about the video for Yakir"?

Scene 2

At authority Biton's office

Biton: Before we give the papers the right to speak, I wanted to offer my condolences on your father may he rest in peace.

Ayelet:+ Sella: Thank you very much/You're a good person

Biton: I got to know the deceased and I had the utmost respect for him, Your father was a very special person, He set with me right here Had some tea, And told me all about the atrocities that he had to go threw there...

He talks about the holocaust

Gur: aaa... Our father is not from 'there', Our father is from Petah Tiqwa

Petah Tiqwa – town in Israel

Little pause

Biton: You're not Yitzhak Helbitz's children, God rest his soul?

Gur: We are Yaakov Barkai's children, God rest his soul...

Biton: Wow this is embarrassing, Wow this is embarrassing. Opening a will is such a sensitive situation and look at me, Talking about Helbitz like a jerk... It's probably the fuzziness for the shot... **Checks the will papers** Here you go, of course! Yaakov Barkai, of course! Yaakov Barkai!

I got to know the deceased and I had the utmost respect for him
Your father was a very special person, He set with me right here
Had some tea, And told me all about the atrocities that he had in...
Petah Tiqwa. So, the will...

Ayelet:+ Gur: yes/ooo

Biton: Were you offered something to drink?

Ayelet:+ Gur: that's fine we can just.../No thanks

Sella: I would actually Love some tea.

Biton: Ronit!

Ravit: **from the lobby** Ravit!

Biton: Not only you can't tell them apart, but their mother, bless her, gave them similar names: Ronit. Ronit...

Ravit enters, still on the phone

Ravit: **to the phone...** NO Ronit, we said you're working on Wednesday Because I have a PTA meeting at the Judo-

Biton: Ravit! We have clients for tea

Ravit: What would you like? Chamomile, Masala chai, lemongrass, lemon verbena, green tea, mint tea, lemon mint, Stevia mint, wild cranberry, wild fruits, forest fruits, magical garden, hibiscus, hibiscus wild rose, sage delights, fruits delights, magical peach, magical cinnamon, honey cinnamon, ginger cinnamon, mint cinnamon, cinnamon, almond sunset And wormwood...

Sella: (thinks) mmm Lemongrass

Ravit: Fine. How much sugar?

Sella: Do you have honey?

Ravit: No honey.

Biton: Edelstein doesn't have honey?

Ravit: He never has honey.

Biton: We need to have honey, People want honey these days

Ayelet: Ok. Tea **with no** honey for him, strong black coffee for me, and light instant coffee with a lot of milk for the little baby here.

Gur: Can we not call me little baby in front of people?

Biton: And check if Edelstein has some pain killers.

Ravit: What?

Biton: Pain killers from Edelstein!

Ravit: Fine! **On the way out to the phone** Ronit, he's taking the wisdom tooth pain out on me, I don't need you too

She's out

Biton: Here we go. Ok people, let's begin.

Begins reading the will. His speech is very unclear

"I, Yaakov Barkai, ID number 050815299, hereby state that this is my last will in testament as it was written at attorney Mr. Yariv Biton's law firm, license number 2030573 on the 25th "

Gur: excuse me, sorry... is it ok if it's not you who reads the will?

Biton: Sorry?

Gur: is it ok if it's not you who reads the will?

Biton: Why did you put emphasis on the "you"?

Gur: Since you are...

Biton: I am what? Because I'm a Biton? Then go to Edelstein, or to Perlstein if Biton is not good enough for you.

Biton- A Mizrahi surname. Edlshtain and Perlshtain - An Ashkenazi surname

Ayelet: No, no, no, god forbid, you're good enough for us, you're a great attorney, It's just that it's kind of hard to understand what you're reading And it's very important for us to understand what these papers say, So can my little brother read the will instead of you?

Sella: Excuse me, why don't your big brother read the will?

Ayelet: Because you're dyslectic Sella, and Gur is an actor

Sella: So If I came to the funeral you wouldn't have let me read the prayer?

Gur: But you didn't come to the funeral, right Sella?

Sella: Go eat mac and cheese!

Gur: You go eat mac and cheese.

Biton: People! This debate is unnecessary. **I** will read the will since this is what your father had asked. Anything that is said and done here is what your father had asked. So excuse my speaking impairment, trust me I did not ask to receive an anesthesia shot and I definitely did not ask to be in a hell of a lot of pain... **suddenly he notices Sela**

has been making a joint on one of the pages What exactly are you doing?

Sella: What? I thought I'd smoke for a bit, is that alright? I just need a working surface for the weed... What? Do you need this page?

Biton takes the paper, shakes it to get rid of any weed or tabacoo, and continues reading

Biton: "My children" this is what your father wrote "Before you hear my last will and testament, please remember what your mother has asked you From the day you were born: Don't...

All: Don't fight...

Biton: "Mom always said the relationship between siblings is the longest relationship." That's true, by the way "and do everything in your power so you don't fight" now we are getting to the matter at hand, "I, Yaakov Barkai, ID number" this and that "hereby bestow and bequeath my all my estate to attorney Mr. Yariv Biton that has served me well in my last years"

pause

Gur: What was that?

Ayelet: He gave all his money to you?

Biton: So it seems

Gur: What do you mean "so it seems"? Excuse me, you wrote that will

Biton: I just wrote what your father dictated, People, I'm sorry but this is what it says here... Guys, I'm messing with you!

Sella is laughing hard. Gur and Ayelet stand up

Ayelet+ Gur: No, no, listen-/This is not funny

Biton: It's my routine joke

Gur: Your routine joke is very annoying and not funny.

Sella: It's very funny!

Ayelet: No, Sella, I'm sorry but it's stupid and not funny at all, it's out of place!

Biton: Opening a will is such a tense moment , so I thought it would be nice to let out some steam with a good joke.

Ayelet: Did you steam out? You wanna steam out some more jokes?

Sella: You're amazing man.

Biton: "I hereby bestow and bequeath my all my Liquid Capital" which means Everything he had in is bank account and whatever is left from his military pension. Where did your father serve in the military?

Gur : He was an I.O for the northern command.

Biton: I.O?

Ayelet+ Gur+Sella: Intelligence Officer.

Biton: Oh, I.O, Intelligence officer, I.O., nice... I was in the southern command But in the quartermaster corps

Ayelet How much is left from the pension?

Biton: I'm ignoring this. In his pension he has 173,591 shekels... **Gur begins typing the numbers on his phone** In his study fund he had... Oh wow

Ayelet+ Gur+Sella: What?/how much?/what?

Biton: The anesthesia is wearing off... In his study fund He had 67,453 shekels, In his short-term deposit... It's a mistake to put money in a short-term deposit, 91,544 shekels, And in the checking account he had... **he looks for something** What going on? I'm missing a page...

Biton, Ayelet and Gur search for the missing paper with their eyes, and then notice Sella is making joint on the paper. They stare At him untile he realizes

Sella: You need this page too? You need all of them?

Biton takes the paper, shakes it to get rid of any weed or tabacoo, and continues reading

Biton: In his checking account, he had 207,327 shekels, "all of these will divide equally between my three children- Sella, Ayelet, and Gur"

Ayelet: That's all? each one of us is getting less than 200 thousand

Gur: Each one is getting 179... almost 180 thousand...

Sella: Amazing.

Ayelet: What's so amazing? 180 thousand shekels?!

Biton: And you need to remember the 1% commission fee that goes to me

Gur: Our father didn't pay you your commission fee?

Biton: You know what, out of respect for your late father, I am willing to waive my commission fee.

Sella: Really?

Biton: No, I'm messing with you again!

Sella is laughing hard again

Sella: I love you man!

Ayelet: I don't understand this. How come there's so little money?

Gur: Ask your brother

Sella: Me?

Gur: Sella, how much money did you take from dad to open your "business"?

Sella: I thought it would go like crazy.

Gur: Organized trips for redheads only?!

Sella: Redheads can't take a trip in the sun like everybody

Gur: Did you fund your six months in New Zealand by waitressing?

Sella: Go eat mac and cheese!

Gur: You go eat mac and cheese!

Ayelet: I wanted to buy a car

Gur: You'll buy a car, Ayelet. You're getting 180 thousand.

Ayelet: But I wanted to leave something for the kids in case I...

Gur: In case what?

Ayelet: In case something happens, Gur. Things happen in life

Gur: Ok, why are we stressing? the 180 thousand is not everything, there's the apartment too.

Biton: Right, the apartment. **Reads** "The apartment on Hill's Shadow st. number 72, I hereby bestow to Ms. Yafit Atias, ID number 021985387

Sella is laughing hard again

The content of said apartment will be kept for 30 days as stated by law”

Sella: hhhh who did you say he bestowed the apartment to?

Biton: Ms. Yafit Atias. Can I please continue ?

Ayelet: No, we’re just waiting for you to say you’re messing with us
Sella will laugh like a jerk, and then you can continue.

Sella: hhhh “Yafit Atias” hhhh

Biton: I have two routine jokes, both of which I already made.

He serves them the will papers. The three siblings look at it in astonishment

Ayelet: Who’s Yafit Atias?

Biton: She inherited the apartment on Hill’s Shadow st. number 72.

Gur: Why in hell would our father give the apartment to some Yafit Atias?

Biton: That you’ll have to ask your father

Ayelet: But our father is dead

Sella: And I still didn’t say my goodbyes to him.

Ayelet: Who’s Yafit Atias?

Biton: Why did you put emphasis on the “**Atias**”?

Ayelet: What?

Biton: You said: “who is Yafit **Atias**?”

Ayelet: Right, exactly, I meant -

Biton: You meant why would my father give the apartment to someone with a surname like **Atias**, Or **Guetta** or **Biton**, But if he gave the apartment to some **Edelstein** or **Perlstein**, that would be conceivable, right?

Gur: No! My sister meant why would our father give the apartment to someone not from our family?

Biton: Right, someone from the **Atias** family

Ayelet: Enough with this **Atias**! Who is this Yafit Atias?

Biton: Ok, let's sit down, let's relax, I want us to sign the will.

Ayelet: We will not relax, and we will not sign! What are we supposed to do now?

Sella: Look, sometimes the universe puts us to a test to teach us something-

Ayelet: Sella I don't care about the universe right now! What are supposed to do with the apartment?

Biton: You don't need to do anything, I'll transfer it to Ms. Atias.

Ayelet: You won't transfer anything to her!

Gur: Mr. Biton, you're our attorney you tell us-

Biton: No, no, no, big mistake my friend, I am your father's attorney may he rest in peace, I'm trusted with executing this will!

Ayelet: This is not happening to me, this is not happening to me...

Gur: So what can we do now if we want to get our house now?

Biton: You have two options: A. you can kill me, destroy the will
And then by law, your father's assets will go to its lawful inherits, which are you. Do you want to kill me?

Sella: mmm I don't think we'll go with it.

Biton: So you can take an "inheritance disclaimer" paper, Trace Ms. Atias, and convince her to decline a four-bedroom apartment.

Ayelet: So that's what we'll do, give us those papers!

Biton: Ronit!

Ravit: **from outside** Ravit!

Biton: Prepare the "inheritance disclaimer" papers!

Gur: And her number.

Biton: Who's number?

Sella+Ayelet+Gur :Yafit Atias'!

Biton: But it's confidential. I can't give you Yafit Atias' phone number without your father's permission.

Ayelet: But our father is dead!

Sella: And I still didn't say my goodbyes to him.

Ayelet: That's it, I'm done. **Goes to the door**

Biton: Can I give you a piece of legal advice?

He waits until the three siblings come close to him

Sign this will. 180,000 shekels is a nice sum of money, And after Ms. Atias gets the apartment you can turn to court and-

Ayelet: Mr. Biton, I would rather die before some Ms. Atias gets my home!

Ravit enters with forms, and a tray with hot drinks on it

Ravit: "inheritance disclaimer"

Ayelet grabs the form from Ravit and leaves the office, Gur and Sella follow her out

Ravit: ... What about the coffee, the tea? Gur what about that video for Yakir? –

End of scene 2

Act 2 – The house

The whole act plays out at Barkai family's apartment

Scene 3

Lights come up on Yaakov Barkai's apartment. The apartment looks like a war room with pictures of various women and notes hung on the wall. Gur is alone in the apartment, talking on the phone

Gur: Barkai... Barkai... Yaakov Barkai, Right, Barkai with a K

He was an I.O. for the northern command, An Intelligence officer for the northern command-

Ayelet enters

Ayelet: Go eat mac and cheese! You hear me? Go eat mac and cheese! Why aren't you answering your call waiting? You know I don't have the keys to dad's apartment!

Gur: **to the phone** Thank you Yafit. **Hanging up** Well, it's not Yafit Atias from Kfar Yona either.

Kfar Yona – small town in Israel

Ayelet: Gur what is this? Did you open an operations room?

Gur: O.k, according Google there are 51 Yafit Atias. I got a hold on 19. None of them has heard the name Yaakov Barkai but... my odds are on Yafit Atias the dental hygienist. **Pointing to one of the photos**

Ayelet: What does a dental hygienist have-

Gur: Dad was obsessed with his teeth...

Ayelet: And?!

Gur: I donk know Ayelet, maybe dad got attached to his dental hygienist and decided to leave her the apartment, Or he could have left it to Yafit Atias from the AT&T customer service **Pointing to another picture** Maybe she helped him connect to the Internet.

Ayelet: Gur, drop it, I have a way to solve this -

Gur: **Pointing to another picture** there's a 70-year-old Yafit Atias from Vancouver –

Ayelet: Gur-

Gur: **Pointing to another picture** there's a Yafit Atias from Kiryat Motzkin
Kiryat Motzkin – town in Israel

Ayelet: Gur, That's a three-year-old girl!

Gur: Yeah, I know, I'll talk to her tomorrow after preschool
And our prime suspect **Pointing to another picture** Yafit Atis from Animal Rights.

Ayelet: Animal Rights?!

Gur: Dad loved dogs!

Ayelet: Gur! dad did not leave the house to someone who cleaned his teeth
Or to someone from Animal Rights, Dad left the apartment to his lover...

Pause

Gur: That's exactly what Moran said

Ayelet: And that what anyone past the age of four would tell you

Gur: Dad did not have a lover!

Ayelet: Remember dad would go every year to Olga Hill for his retreat?

Gur: That's a retreat for military officers!

Ayelet: That's right! And what do they do at the retreat?

Gur: They go to some Olga and retreat!

Gur: Give me a break

Ayelet: Forget it, forget it, Gur

Gur: You can believe whatever you want

For all I care, you can believe dad was a virgin

Now, write a check for 20,000 shekels

Gur: 20,000 shekels? Why not a million?

Ayelet: It's not for me you moron!

It's to solve the...

I talked to some people today

Gur: What people?

Ayelet: Georgians

Gur: What Georgians?

Ayelet: Georgians, Georgians. I'm meeting with them tonight, I'll give them 20,000 shekels and they'll find her.

Gur: How will they find her?

Ayelet: I don't know They're Georgians they have their ways! They'll find her and make her sign the inheritance disclaimer.

Gur: Do you understand what would happen if someone finds out

Gur the Traffic Sign messed with the Georgian mob?

Ayelet: You got a better idea?

Gur: Yes I do! I'll find her, and i will Explain to her how our father was a sick old man And that there has been a mistake, she'll understand there has been a mistake.

Ayelet: And if she wouldn't understand?

Gur: We'll take her to court! Yes It might take three or four years but the house-

Ayelet: You can wait for three or four years, I don't have three or four years! And we aren't going to any court!

Gur: Do you have a better idea?

Ayelet: Yes I do have a better idea!

Gur: An idea which does not include Georgians?

Ayelet: I have a great idea! Go eat mac and cheese!

Gur: You go eat mac and cheese!

Ayelet: No, you go eat mac and cheese!

Sella enters from the bedroom. He is very sleepy and wear an old pajamas

Sella: Maybe I'll eat mac and cheese?

Ayelet: Sella, did you sleep in dad's room?

Gur: Did you sleep in dad's pajamas?

Sella: Don't ask what I've been through after we were at the attorney's office...

Gur: Sella tell her dad didn't have a lover!

Ayelet: Sella tell him to give me 20,000 shekels!

Sella: Can I wake up first?

Gur: Fine, If you guys don't want to help me then thank you very much

לוקח את הג'קט שלו והולך לכיוון הדלת

Ayelet: Gur, don't be a little baby.

גור מצביע על המפתחות שליד הדלת

Gur: Sella keep this key, it's the only one we've got.

פותח את הדלת ויוצא, איילת יוצאת אחריו

Ayelet: Come on! I can't go to the Georgians empty-handed!

Sella: You guys listening? I found her... I found Yafit Atias.

גור ואיילת חוזרים

Ayelet: You found Yafit Atias?
Gur: Are you certain it's the right one? Causes there are a lot of Yafit Atias.
Ayelet: You found dad's Yafit Atias?
Sella: Dad's one.
Gur: Is she from Animal Rights?
Ayelet: Enough Gur! how did you find her?
Sella: Just a sec Let's smoke something and then we can talk...
Ayelet: Sella how did you find her?!
Gur: Sella please! Talk!

סלע נאנח ומתחיל לספר, הדיבור שלו איטי ומגומגם מה שמשגע כמוכן את גור ואיילת

Sella: What had happened was... After we left the attorney's office
I drove to the cemetery, When I saw the little sign with his name
And the withered flowers on the...I laid on the ground covering
him, And felt dad's body under me, for real... And we hugged
That was one hell of a hug, mmm And then I wanted to smoke
something, and what do I see?
Ayelet: The point of this story, I hope!!!
Sella: I take out the paper with the weed, And I noticed I accidentally
took the page with the information from the attorney.
Gur: You kept weed in dad's will?

In Hebrew people don't use the word 'weed', but rather the slang word: 'Ksessa', which means a mix of weed and tobacco

Sella: מראה להם את הדף Yafit Atias, I.D, phone number, everything...
Ayelet: Sella! you're a genius!
Sella: You ask a question and the universe answers.
Gur: Hold on Sella, I hope you didn't call her...?
Sella: No. I cried some more, smoked some more, And then I called...
Ayelet: Sella you talked to her?

Sella: Yes, I said "hello"...

Ayelet: **And?**

Sella: "My name is Sella, and I want to meet you..."

Gur: When you talked to her did you hear dog noises?

Ayelet: Stop it Gur she's not from Animal Rights!

Gur: She's yes from Animal Rights!

Ayelet: Sella, did she say something about the house?

Gur: did she say something about the house?

Sella: I don't know, Ayelet! Come one! Would you let a person wake up?

גור ואיילת מרפים ממנו ומביטים בדף עם הפרטים שלה

Sella: You can ask her when she comes.

pause

Gur: Comes where?

Sella: Here. I thought it was best if we met here, right?

Ayelet: Wrong Sella! It's not 'Best' in any way!

Sella: What? Why?

Gur: Here Sella? At the house dad left her?

Ayelet: When did say you were meeting her?

Sella: Evening, late at night, nine-thirty, ten even

Gur: **מביט בשעון שלו** Ok - It's nine

דפיקות בדלת. שלושת האחים קופאים

Sella: Yeah, maybe nine.

Ayelet: I'm calling the Georgians!

Gur: Ayelet, drop the Georgians, Sella drop the joint, hold on

Gur: Let's see who she is, it must be a mistake.

איילת וגור תולשים את כל התמונות של הבחורות שגור תלה על הקיר ומסתירים אותן

Ayelet: Not a word about the house, she might not know about it

Sella: Why are you hysterical? I got this, I'll talk to her
Ayelet: That's exactly why we're hysterical!
Gur: **to the door** Just a moment! **whisper** I'm opening the door
Ayelet: Calm!
Gur: No talking about the house.
Ayelet: Sella, Don't mention the word house.
Gur: Sella, no talking about the house.

גור פותח את הדלת ושם עומדת בחורה צעירה ויפה. השלושה מביטים בה בתדהמה ולא מוציאים מילה

Hello

May I come in?

Our house is your house

Nice house

It's not that nice, and very old by the way

It's what you got

It's very loud here during the day

Super expensive maintenance

The important thing is you got a house

Ok, how are we doing this?

So... you know what this is about?

Yes, I know what this is about

How do I begin

We start by me getting what I deserve

Any problems?

No problems, would you like a cup of tea?

I want money

You think we have that kind of money here?

You think I accept checks?

You want it all in cash?

You think I take credit cards?

Perhaps we should get to know each other before we get to the money

We've gotten to know each other, nice to meet you

I have pepper spray here, I have a knife here

You wanna get to know them too? Or is someone going to hand me 800 shekels?

800 shekels?

And not a shekel less

Any Problems?

No problems, Gur give her 800 shekels

Why me?

Cause you're the youngest

You have 34 minutes left

You can split them however you want, I don't care

I don't do stuff together

I don't do kinky stuff

I don't do with no rubber

I got handcuffs for anyone who likes it

But I don't do beating

If you didn't take a shower now's the time

You got a bedroom or something?

Give me a minute before you come in

Well, I don't think she's from Animal Rights

What a character ha?

No even to his lover... to his prostitute

No, it can't be

What a mess ha?

Aweeee dad left his apartment to a, aweeee

What do we do now? There can be a pro-

I got this

You have some coffee I'll talk to her

Come here, listen

She knows nothing about the apartment, thank god

I have the inheritance disclaimer form here

We'll write her a nice check

She'll sign, and that's it

No, hold on, there must be a mistake, I know dad

Dad wouldn't have paid for sex

Sella, all men pay for sex

I don't pay for sex

I don't pay for sex

because you're not a man

and you've got nothing to pay with

how much are we offering her? 5000?

5000

But why use money?

Let's talk to her, I'm sure she'll understand

Sure, she'll understand

And go straight to Biton to take your home

If it's deceit we're talking about, I'm out

You go in Gur, you good with doing business

What if she's naked?

So what?

It's scary

I beginning to see why you're not pregnant yet

If you want to watch, it's an extra 300

Actually, we wanted to talk to you

Talk? What are you some kind of perverts?

Look I'll be honest with you- we're brothers

Boy you really are perverts

My name is Ayelet and this is Gur and the one in the living room is-

I don't care what your names are

And we know you are Yafit Atias

Fuck

Fuck! I knew it

Social Security I knew it!

No, we're not from-

Fuck! I should have guessed you were ambushing me when I saw a woman in the room!

We are not from Social Security!

A social worker was at my place a month ago

We are not from Social Security! We swear we are not from Social Security!

We are not from Social Security

So how do you know my name?

Our father was one of your clients

What?

Our father was one of your clients

And your father, that was one of my clients

How did he know my name?

We don't know and honestly, we can't really ask him

Because he's taking a nap right now at the cemetery

I don't get it

Our father died a few days ago

And that's what you do at the Shiva?

Call an escort girl?

Before our father had passed, he asked us to respect you

To respect me?

Yes

So what do you want to do?

Name a street after me?

No, no we thought about something easier If it's ok with you

Who is your father?

Yaakov Barkai. Do you know that name?

You think I know my clients' names?

Here, that's him. Do you recognize him?

No

You don't recognize?

I said no, didn't I?

And even if I would have recognized I wouldn't have said a word

So you do recognize

Recognize or don't recognize, we just want to fulfill our father's last wish

And give you some money so 5-

20,000

20,000?!

20,000

Fine than 30,000

30,000 shekels?

Shut up

Sit

Let's make a deal

You don't fuck with my head and tell me what you want

And I won't spray your faces, deal?

Why do you think we're fuckin with your head?

'cause there's no such thing as giving money to someone without wanting something in return

That's western society for you!

Yafit, listen, it's not that complicated

I'm not an expert in the "profession"

But does it sometimes happen when clients want to leave a tip?

And?

So our father, who apparently really appreciated your work

Asked us to tip you

A 30,000 shekels tip

So allow us to fulfill our father's last wish, God rest his soul

And we can go our separate ways, ok?

Fine

So sex is not your thing?

I only do it with my wife

So, come on

Really?

Come on let me get dressed

Ok thank you, get out

And when you come out, you'll have a nice tip waiting for you

30,000 shekels?

It just came out of my mouth

I'm only a human being

Stop being such so cheap

You'll pay me back right?!

Listen, I thought about it and there is no way she was dad's prostitute

Sella, she recognized him

But she didn't recognize him

Come on don't be a baby, of course she recognised him

She knew him, she's just acting all discreet

Of course she knew him, she loved dad

Sella, what did you smoke?

There must have been love there if he wanted her to have the house

Shhhh!

But how do we get her to sign the disclaimer?

She'll see the money and sign whatever you want.

Sign the check Gur

Hold it with the money, you're not buying her

She's used to people buying her, Sella

What type of expense should I call this? I have to report this

Dad had some kind of intention here

Right, an intention to give our apartment to a prostitute

I'll call it "artistic accompanying services"

Don't you see we have a chance to discover something we didn't know about dad?

Sella, what I discovered about my dad today is enough for me

Listen... I won't, I won't

I want the apartment as well but I'm the older brother

And I must take care of what dad wanted

What kind of an older brother are you?
What have you taught us except burping?
What is this good for Gur?
Suddenly what dad wanted is important to you?
Maybe dad wanted to see you before he died
Both of you can go eat mac and cheese
Did you finish fighting?
No, we don't fight
Here you go, Yafit
Is there a way for you to give me a receipt by any chance?
I can get a refund from the IRS...
Here you go
Thank you and...
I'm sorry for your loss
Yafit! Can I ask you a small favor?
I knew it
It's just that, our father asked us to sign you on this paper
What paper?
Just a paper that says you received money from us
I'm not signing anything
It's just formalities
I don't want formalities
Isn't it a shame? Without the signature on the paper we can't give you the money
You can't? if you can't then you can't
Wait Yafit! Come on, Yafit!
Yafit hold on please, look...
I didn't want to pull this card but...

I'm a famous person

It's probably hard to recognize me without the...

I'm Gur the Traffic Sign

Don't you know Gur the Traffic Sign?

Didn't get a license

Do you have any kids?

None of your business

I'm just saying, if you had any kids you would have known I'm very famous

And wouldn't dare trick you

Goodnight

What happened? Where did all those principles come from?

Excuse me for not getting it, but what's your deal?

The universe knocks at your door, wants to give you a gift

How can you say no?

Come on Yafit

You won't say no to this much money because of a little signature Would you?

Again

Goodnight

We still have 11 minutes left!

When the client is done, I'm out

But we're not done

When you took those papers out, you were done

Fine we'll give you another 800 shekels

you can buy your mother like that not me!

My mother is dead

You can die too!

It will happen soon I have cancer

Bless you honey

I really do have cancer

I have a tumor in my thyroid gland

It's the same type of cancer my dad had

You want to see the test results

Ayelet, you really have...?

See, I haven't even told my brother

Why are you...

Why am I telling this to you?

Because you're right, what can I say?

You're right, we haven't told you the whole truth earlier

Your signature on the paper, we must have it

Because according to my father's will won't get anything

Unless you sign that we have respected you

Ayelet, you really have-

Stop Gur! I have cancer and let's not talk about it, ok?

Look my brothers don't need this inheritance

Really, my older brother is good if he has something to smoke

My younger brother is drowning in money

I'm not drowning-

Gur shut up please!

I really really need this money

I have a 17-year-old daughter named Lotus

I have a 15-year-old son named Yotam

And they don't have a dad

I mean they do have a dad but, his new wife won't take my kids when I'm gone

And I have to leave them something, Yafit

So please, let my brother write you a new check, scribal your name here
I swear it's just a form that says you received money from us, and that's it

We won't bother you again with our family issues

Give it here

When did the find it?

Not now

Name, ID and a signature down there

You want a glass of water?

Yes Gur. A glass of water will cure my cancer!

Why be like that? He's worried about you

Right, you're right, sorry Gur, sorry

Am I allowed to come in and take a lighter? Thank you so much

You should have told me the truth from the get-go

You told her the truth?

They did

So what's the rush, come sit

Sella? What?

No, I have to go

She has to go!

Thank you, and

Get better soon

Thank you

Yafit?

Can I hug you?

Sella!

Just a small hug? It'll be like hugging dad

Come on, I did worse things for money

You're lovely
I'm not surprised dad left you the apartment
What apartment?
So you didn't tell her?
Your dad left me this apartment?
That's not exactly right
What did you sign me on?
Sella I am going to kill you!
Give it to me
I suggest we drink some verbena tea
Don't touch me!
Git to me right now
I'd rather die!
you will die!
I'm calling the police!
You can't call the police I'm Gur the Traffic Sign!
If that's the way you want it
What is she doing?
She locked the house
Nobody leaves until I get those papers!
Listen, I think...
I think I solved what just happened
Look, are you listening Yafit?
Our dad was very sick
He was afraid of dying
He wanted to feel the touch of a woman one last time
So he didn't have the time to go look for a partner

So he called you, probably got really excited

Which is understandable, you know, a person who had gone through 4 years of chemo, sees a beautiful woman like you with all your...

And falls in love

Are you listening Yafit?

I'm listening. Go on, go on.

And I, unlike my siblings here, don't oppose the relationship you had with dad

On the contrary, I hug this relationship

I hug that dad felt loved in his last years

That he had sex

I really do hug this

But, and these a but here

We were born in this house

Our mother died in this house

Our lives are spread all over these walls

Do you understand, Yafit?

Yes, I understand

There's no other way, I'm gonna have to renovate

You won't do a thing!

You think I wanna renovate? Do you know what a headache it is to renovate?

But what else can I do the house is a mess

Yafit, can you open the door for me? I need to go home

You will all go, but not before your sister gives me the papers

Ayelet give her the papers, I have a show tomorrow

Don't you have clients waiting for you?

What do I need clients for? I have a four-bedroom apartment

You don't have a four-bedroom apartment

Forget the apartment. We'll manage the apartment, right?

No, we won't manage, Sella!

Look where you got us Ayelet

Where I got us? Rally?! Did I tell her dad left her the apartment?

Is it my fault I'm an honest person?

Go eat mac and cheese!

You go eat mac and cheese!

Stop it! What are we? Little children?

Yafit, can I give you a piece of advice?

What? Don't renovate? It's better to sell

You do understand you won't get this house without going to court, right?

You won't get this house in any way

Ayelet, give me a moment please!

Do you know how long this kind of trail is gonna take?

4 years at the minimum. Do you know how much an attorney charges for an hour?

About the same as you

Enough with the money, all you talk about is money

Stop it! Stop!

And you know what will happen if you decide to make this mistake, and go to court against us?

What will happen?

The court would favor the deceased' children

rather than the woman who provided him sex services

Isn't it best for you to just take the 30,00 shekels we gave you?

The house is better, isn't it?

Fine! I'm adding 50,000 shekels! You're paying me back, right?

Did you hear me Yafit? I'm offering you 80,000 shekels!

You're talking money again?

Sella, Give me a sec!

Yafit, come on, think about it, you came here for 800 shekels

I'm offering you 80,000. Don't tell me it's a bad deal

It's a good deal

Really, it's a good deal. Can I ask a question?

Are taking the books, or should I donate them?

If it's about money-

Move it! Move it!

No you listen to me, you have kids right?

None of your business

I know you have kids, come on I can tell you're a mom

You have kids? What are their names?

Not now!

You want to raise them here, right?

So tomorrow morning I'm giving Efrat Gafni a cell

She's a friend of mine from Social Security

Why use threats?

Shut up Sella!

I'll tell her what you do for work and they take your kids from you

So I honestly suggest you-

If you send Efrat Gafni for my kids, Ill send Sagit Shasho from Neve Tirza prison, you got me?

I'm not affrei-

And it's the last time to mention my boy

Yafit listen, our dad

Enough with your dad! I have no idea who your father was ok?

What do you mean you have no idea?

No idea! I don't remember your father and I don't remember any clients
That's the way it works! Not a face, not a name, nothing!
When I go through the door everything gets erased
So if you don't remember our dad-
If I don't remember, then what? You wanna go to court with me?
Let's go to court. Let's see who'll take their kids to see your shows
after they hear you called an escort girl
I didn't call an escort!
Enough! I don't want to hear it!
Your dad left this apartment to me
Not to you. To me.
And you know what? I don't care if your dad fell in love with me
Or if he was high from the chemo
Because from now on this apartment is mine,
So I suggest you take all your souvenirs from here,
And take all your shit, cause tomorrow I'm calling the movers and throwing
everything!
Ayelet, what are you doing?
What is she doing?
Now let's see you take me out of here
Ayelet, come on, I'm attached to the house as well, but why handcuffs?

Nobody is leaving, Gur
Ayelet enough! Give here the papers I have a show-
Stop it Gur! Stop! For once in your life try to deal with things!
Stop acting like a baby!
Don't call me a baby I'm 44 years old!

Can someone take me to pee, I can't...

Come, I'll take you, come sweetheart

I'm a good enough older brother for that, right?

Just so you, I didn't lie about having cancer earlier

These are my latest tests results

So I'm not scared of you knife, or your pimp, or you tear spray

The only way I'm leaving this house is in a casket

What type of tumor do you have?

Cancer tumor, "What type?"

Yeah, I didn't think you were growing cilantro

Is it a Follicular or a Papillary tumor?

What?

It's...what?

It's Follicular

Follicular is less of a big deal

When were you diagnosed?

A month and a half ago

I meant 'when' as in what size is it?

Oh, I don't know...like

1.5 centimeters

Yes, something like that, yes

Well, I've got bad news for you

You're not going to die from this cancer

My father died from this cancer

Your dad was old or was diagnosed late, you're on stage one, baby

It hasn't even spread to your Lymphatics

My tumor was 4 centimeters when I was diagnosed

You have cancer too?

Had

In the thyroid gland?

See? And they say it's rare

And?

And they removed the gland, they removed the Lymphatics

4 years of treatment

No...

But I got out of it

Are you getting treated here at the oncology institute?

What? Yes, I am

With Doctor Vaks?

Yes

Send her my regards

Trust her, she's good

Listen, I'm totally new at this, I haven't even processed it

I didn't tell nearly anyone

How old did you say your kids are?

Fifteen and seventeen

They need to get checked every year

Thyroid gland cancer is hereditary, your father had it

You really don't remember my father?

I really don't remember my clients

You don't remember someone with thyroid gland cancer

Baby, I did many things to my client

A biopsy is not one of them

So I'm not dying?

Maybe if I stab you, you will

But not from this tiny tumor

Ok, calm down, this does not mean I'm giving up the house I have kids

I have a kid too, and you see what his mom does for a living

Hi! I'm a third-grade Bible teacher!

The things you do for money...

I told you to let me hold it

What happened?

I won't let you hold it!

What?

Don't tell her

He peed all over himself

But I asked you not to, didn't I?

Ok ok, let's go find you some PJ's

Forget the PJ's hang him straight on the hanger!

Funny, very funny!

Leave it!

I want to help you!

I don't want your help! I can do it alone

I suggest you change underwear

It's ok they're not wet

No, change to a different type of underwear, with a fabric that can breathe more

Why does my underwear need to breathe?

You need to air the whole area

I don't even wear underwear, but see, you

To you it's especially important if you're trying to get pregnant

How do you know? Ayelet told you?

No, Moran told me

Moran?

Yes

Since when do you keep in touch with Moran?

Excuse me? She's my sister-in-law, you don't talk to me

I want to know how you're doing, so I talk to Moran sometimes

I got you this potion from Ecuador. It's made from forest moss

Which helps with getting pregnant apparently

Sella, about what I said earlier with dad wanting to see you...

Yeah, that hurt me

I was very stressed when that Yafit came here

Yeah but that's not the only reason you said it, right?

Right Sella, that's not the only reason

I was angry you weren't here for dad's last days

I couldn't stay here, I couldn't Gur

I was stressed out of my mind

Social insurance wouldn't get off my back

The rent on Salame street- he wanted me to evacuate

The IRS wanted me to download a form from the internet

I don't know how to go on the internet and download forms

I can't deal with this kind of stuff

So I drove to the hospital and I told dad:

"Dad I can't be here, I need to go for like a month"

He told me:

"Son I promise not to drop dead before you return"

He lied to me

So now I don't have dad, and I understand I wasn't really a big brother to you
Sella that's not like...

It's exactly like that

Maybe one day you'd want me to babysit your kids

You don't need anything I have to give you

I promise I won't let them smoke drugs

Sella, don't you... I mean...you've never...

Don't you want kids?

I love kids, really, I do love kids

But I have to stay worries-free

And kids are worries

But if I die without love, I'll never forgive myself

Yeah, but kids, I mean...

For many years I was afraid of kids too, you know

It's a ton of money

But kids! Don't you want someone to take care of you when you're old?

Gur! Kids are not a substitute for a social worker

I already came to the realization that when I get old, I'll only have you and
Ayelet

Sella, about Ayelet...it's a secret

Only I know this for now

Ayelet has cancer in her thyroid gland

Yeah, I know

Since when do you know?

A month or two

She wanted me to sign a paper that if anything happens to her

I'll take care of Yotam and Lotus

You?

Yes. You know she doesn't want to leave them with Doron and his new wife and all

Go eat mac and cheese!

Go eat mac and cheese, you hear me!

Go eat mac and cheese Ayelet!

Why are you so sensitive?

What's wrong?

To Sella? You'd give your kids to Sella?

You had to tell him?!

Why Sella?! Why Sella?!

He's stoned 24 hours a day, he's barely in the country! Why Sella?!

Gur, my kids will not grow with a father like I had!

What? How am I like dad?

Ok... I'll go clean the oven, cause it looks like it hasn't been clean in years

Tell me how am I like dad?

Do you understand now why I didn't tell you I have cancer?
You're a kid Gury, You're a kid
And every time life turns from a children's play to and adult play you run away.
like dad
Because it hurts, right?
But that's life. Raising kids hurts
That's why you won't raise my kids. And I'll tell you something else
That's why you don't have children of your own

I really am like dad!
Always worrying like dad, planning like dad
Cheap like dad
Emotionally detached like dad
All his bad traits he passed on to me
Wow. Dad screwed me over
Not like he screwed me over
You, Sella? He loved you the most!
Remember I got caught with hashish when I was in the army?
When?
Oh yeah, I remember
So dad came to visit me, I thought he'd slap me for all the troubles I gave him
He set in front of me, handed me a can of grape juice and looked at me
I asked him: "Dad are you disappointed with me?"

He said: "Son I'll never be disappointed with you"
Would you look at that, wow
I wish he wouldn't be disappointed with me
You wish? Look at me!
I'm fifty, no family, no money, no love
That's what happens when no one is ever disappointed with you
Now tell me who dad screwed over the most

You're a ladies man like dad, you have a talent for making money like dad
What did I get from him?
Thyroid gland cancer, and a predisposition to overweight
If anyone, dad screwed me over the most
come to think of it, if anyone, your dad screwed me
Yafit, come take a puff
I'll smoke with you only if we don't talk about the house or your father
No talking about anything that's a downer
Yafit, what do you think, listen carefully
About a restaurant, that only serves gout's yogurt
With Za'atar that they ground in front of you
I hate yogurt
She got you!
So tell us something about you! Anything
Are you married?
How can she be married, Sella? She's a...
Why? There are married girls in the profession, I'm not
What's the name of your boy?
Noam

He's four

He's four and he doesn't know Gur the Traffic Sign?!

I love that name Noam...Noam

Noam is such a beautiful name

Yafit listen carefully. What do you think

About a restaurant, that only serves gout's yogurt with-

What happened?

Did I ask her already?!

Yafit, tell me, those clients

No, I mean in a good way

What do you do to a person to make him fall in love with you like that

Kicks his kids to the curve, and leaves you a four-bedroom apartment

But I told you, I don't know why your father left me the apartment

Ayelet leave her alone

One more question, you don't have to answer me

How did you start working as a..?

How did I start working in escort?

Yes. You know, you don't look like a drug addict

Not more than my brother here

And you're smart

It's a downer

But it's interesting

If it makes you feel good

You know Beit Dagan intersection?

You worked at the intersection?

Oh sweetheart before I forget

6,000 shekels I owe you

It was 8...

What?

Never mind

What start-up?

A restaurant that only serves goat's yogurt with Za'atar that they ground in front of you

Your bother is independent now, that's it!

National insurance is a pain!

All that in three weeks?

That's western society: if you want to have a family you have to provide for it

What family, Sella?

I didn't tell you

I'm engaged

Sella!

Get out of here!

I proposed to her with mom's ring, is that alright?

Alright? You're killing me here!

Who's the lucky girl?

You're a little exaggerating, Yafit. You know, we passed our entire lives with our dad

You let her drive the Jeep?

Do I have a choice? My license has been revoked

Revoked? You?

I talked on the phone while driving

“When you drive, you don’t talk, and tell that to your folks!”

Who made the potatoes? So much dry soup

Ayelet, didn’t you make mom’s fish?

No, I didn’t make fish this year

Nobody made fish?

What’s a holiday without fish?

Maybe I made fish

How’s Noam, is he alright over there?

He loves Lotus! Can she come babysit?

Why babysit, you can have her for good

Yotamy I’m hiding the Afikoman! Think about what you going to wish for!

I love you

Is it really ok if we live here until I find a place?

Take your time

I cooked something for you!

What? Matbucha?

Marduma?

Marmuma?

Mafruma?

Horesh Zabzit?

No no! it's something with red and spicy sauce
mac and cheese

What? I thought you liked mac and cheese

You're lucky you're cute

It's a good story

What happened was that after our mom died

And our father-

I mean dad

He would go off to the military and Ayelet would cook for us

It was clear for these two assholes that I was supposed to cook for them

And one day Ayelet made mac and cheese and it was the most
disgusting thing I've ever tasted
